



SKYLIGHT/SOLAR TUBE GUIDELINES

OBJECTIVE/GOAL:

To provide homeowners with guidelines for the installation of skylights on the house or garage roof.

GUIDELINE DETAILS:

- Requests for skylights or solar tubes will be reviewed on an individual basis taking into consideration the proposed location and the impact to the existing house.
- The preferred location for skylights is on the rear roof areas.
- The skylight or solar tube frame should be bronze or black in color to blend with the roof shingles.
- The size, number of skylights or solar tubes, and their proposed location on the house or garage will be considered.
- Skylights should be flat or similar to those existing in the community.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST (items to include with your application):

- PIR (Property Improvement Request) form must be completed and signed by the owner.
- A brochure or picture of the proposed skylight or solar tube.
- A scaled drawing showing the proposed skylight or solar tube location on the roof.
- Skylight or solar tube length, width and depth (if applicable)
- Skylight or solar tube color.
