COMPOST BINS CRITERIA

The Montgomery Village Foundation encourages homeowners to use "green" solutions to protect our environment, including compost bins. To ensure compost bins are harmonious with the aesthetics of our community, they must adhere to the following criteria:

- All compost bins must be located in the rear yard (except in townhomes without a rear yard), must be black, brown, or dark green in color, and installed in a location that minimizes the impact of the compost bin on the neighboring properties.
- Small, portable compost bins that are designed to be picked up and carried around the yard are not considered permanent, and therefore do not need Architectural Review Board approval. All other compost bins do require advanced, written approval from the Architectural Review Board.
- Compost bins must either be pre-fabricated or built in a professional manner. Chicken wire may not be used in the construction of a compost bin.
